Memo

Chieftain Training depth is 0.2m, therefore needs **2.5m tide** = 2.7m depth minimum, more if choppy

Darling Buoy depth is 1.1m, therefore needs **1.6m tide** = 2.7m depth minimum, more if choppy

William depth is 0.9m, therefore needs **1.8m tide** = 2.7m depth minimum, more if choppy
