





Step I. Register for a Sail event account.









Sailevent

- Sign On will open 2-3 hours before racing & close after start
- Use entry list to see who is signed on for this session
- Use edit entry to make changes to Sail number or Crew
 - Add "Duty" to your sail number to gain duty points.
- Sign off / Submit Declaration within 30mins of last finisher










Back up plan

SIs & NoR Key Changes for 2023


NOR

A responsible adult must supervise Sign on & off for an under 18 and remain onsite or afloat in the race area for the duration of the event. Use of Sailevent tally system.

RIBS will endeavour to attend all capsizes or boats with issues but cannot standby a single boat for extended periods as have other boats and duties to consider.

SI12 – Amends to RRS 35 – A boat must finish within 2.5hrs of fleet start, or sunset, whichever is the earlier. Boats passing the finish line after this time will score a DNF.


These notes do not replace the need for sailors to read the NoR and SIs.



Starting

 The Start/Finish line is defined as the transit of the two yellow posts above the race hut. These line up the centre of the race box with Pile B6 on the central pontoon (Not perpendicular across the river). Main channel only

- Please stay clear of the start line area before your 3min.
- Recalled starts will go to the end of the sequence.




Start sequence & Fleet splits

- Start Sequence 3mins, 2mins, 1min, Go.
- Visual signals (Lights) as per Rule 26.
- Watch out for the ebb tide, once over it is a long way back, RO will spot you and call an individual recall.




- 1. The letter denoting the course will be displayed along with the number of laps.
- 2. The part of the course in CAPITAL letters is to be repeated until the number of rounds displayed at the start have been completed. Marks written in lowercase are only rounded/passed once, at the start of the course or as the last mark of the course as the final leg to the finish.
- 3. ED for 2023 Chilling has been renames Stormforce Coaching




Finishing


- 1. Normal Finish is at the Start/Finish line. Best way to get the right length race is set to many laps and shorten.
- Most popular Race shortened pass this mark on the required side and proceed to the start/finish line (Flag F)




4. Race shortened - finish between the RIB and the adjacent mark of the course (Flag S)



5. Race shortened - finish on a transit through piles 6 and 7 (Both Flags S & F)



Race Officer and RIB Duties


- · Read the notes and arrive one hour before Ist start.
- RO/RIB helms must have PB2 certificate as a minimum.
- Bring a capable crew who is over 18, a member (can be Temporary), prepared to go in the water.
- Find Monthly Coordinator at Lobster Quay and ask for advice.






