

IN DAYS BEFORE DUTY

- ✓ Confirm Tide Hi/Lo time and flow during race
- ✓ Understand forecast Wind Speed and Direction
- ✓ Note Sunset time
- ✓ Assess course options
- ✓ Confirm your crew is still available
- ✓ Plan to arrive at LQ 1700-1730

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ON ARRIVAL

- ✓ Talk to Monthly Coordinator
- ✓ Set Courses
- ✓ Confirm start sequence
- ✓ Brief RHIB crews and Starter/recorder.
- ✓ Flags
- ✓ Inflatable mark if needed
- ✓ RIB Checklist

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BEFORE START

- ✓ Move RIBs from pontoon ASAP so dinghies can launch
- ✓ Check course boards correct
- ✓ Record all boats in start area and hand sheet to Starter/recorder.
- ✓ RIB 2 to guide incoming yachts
- ✓ RIB 3 to guide outgoing yachts

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DURING THE RACE

- ✓ Allocate RIBs to a course areas
- ✓ RIB 2 to follow first start out
- ✓ RIB 3 to follow last start
- ✓ Track Leaders and Last of each Fleet
- ✓ Measure average lap time
- ✓ Consider where, when and how to shorten
- ✓ Target average race duration 70 mins
- ✓ Report retirements to the Race box.

WHEN BACK ASHORE

- ✓ RIB 2 cover first boats back return to the river Pontoon and LQ access
- ✓ RO and RIB 3 Follow remaining boats in.
- ✓ Confirm with Starter/recorder all boats are ashore and or

BEFORE RETURNING TO SHORE

Pass this mark on the required side and proceed to the club start/finish line.	
Finish between this flag and the adjacent mark of the course	
Finish on a line between Pile 6&7	

SHORTEN COURSE FLAGS
