IN AN EMERGENCY: dial 999 or call “UK Coastguard” on VHF 16 or 67


1. **Assess the situation and ensure your safety.**
2. **Call 999** immediately if anyone is seriously injured or at risk. Give clear details and advise that the ambulance should drive to the corner of Shore Road Car Park (adjacent to the Harbour Office).
3. **Contact the Harbour Master** on VHF Ch 68 or telephone 01489 576387 (Hamble Harbour Radio) and report the incident. Contact the Duty Flag Officer who will speak to the casualties emergency contact.

4. **Patrol boats:** 

Bring casualties to the Harbour Master’s Pontoon. Approach slowly and call Hamble Harbour Radio before you arrive. Harbour Authority staff are first-aid trained and defibrillators are available (see map ).

5. **Meet the ambulance:** 

A volunteer should go ashore to direct paramedics from the car park to the pontoon gangway. Let them know there are defibrillators nearby.



6. **Immediately report any incident, collision or damage** to the Harbour Master (VHF 68 or 01489 576387) and rcs@warsashsc.org.uk later visit the Harbour and WSC office to complete any required forms.
